Steve was again commended on the excellent condition of the course.

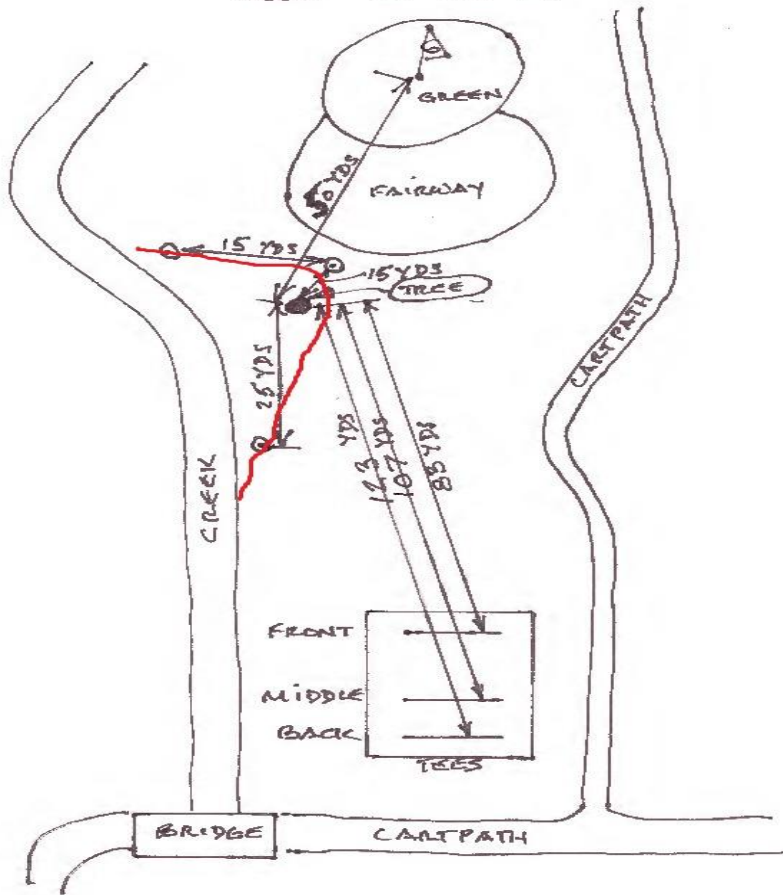
Replacing the missing foot bridge in front of the 3<sup>rd</sup> forward tee will be moving forward. Sue said had talked to Tom Shannon about the steel beams and they would probably be available mid-November. However, no work will start until the Treasure gives the OK at the next BoD meeting. The work will be completed with volunteer labor.

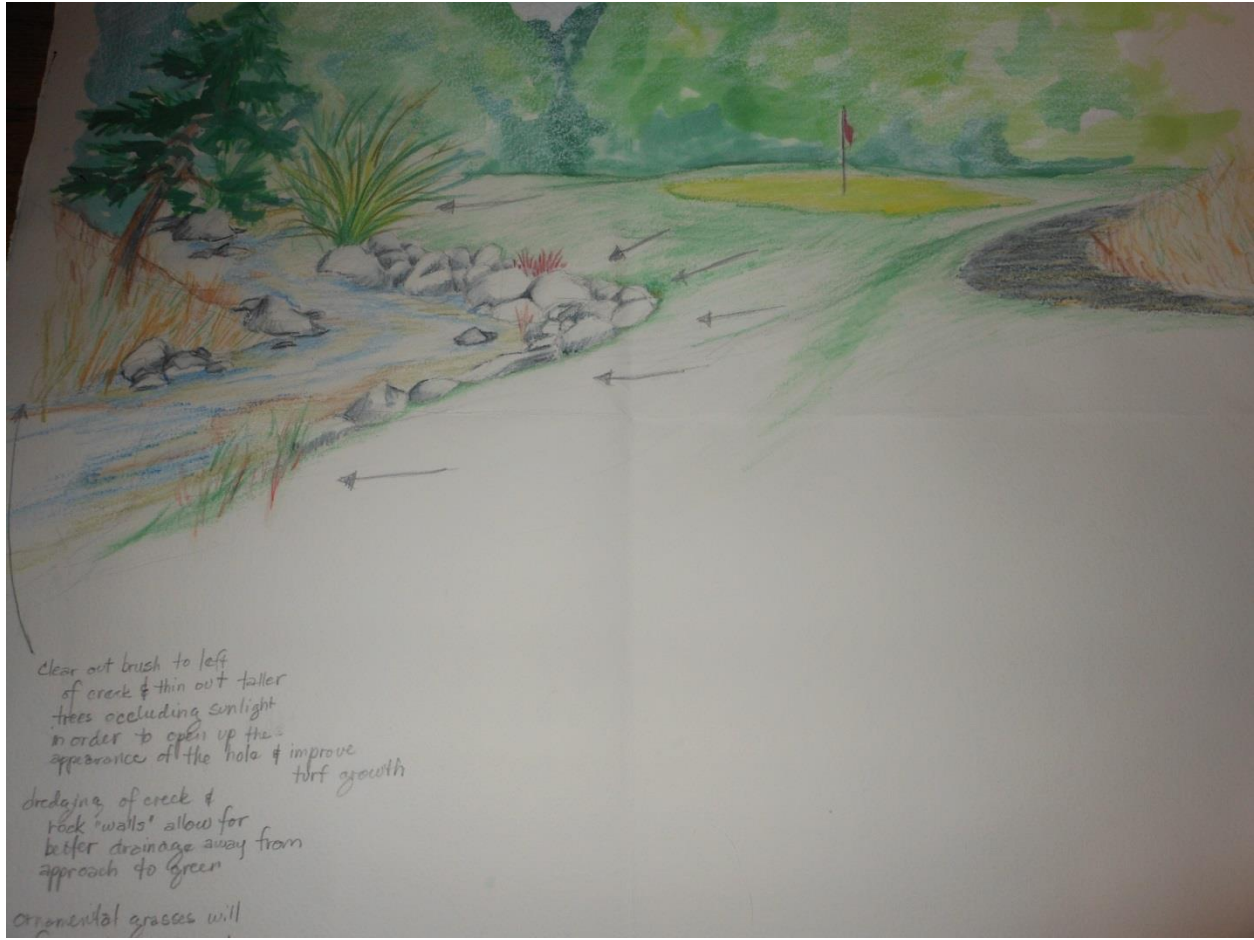
Project day went well with the exception of the work on the 7<sup>th</sup> fairway. It was not completed due to the wet conditions of the ground.

The tree on the 6<sup>th</sup> hole was discussed. Several issues were noted, the tree will not get smaller, the issue returns every year, the cost of installing a bunker, etc. The survey was reviewed and noted that there were 43 votes (48.3%) to "Do nothing" with the tree and 46 votes (51.7%) to "Do something". By a unanimous vote the group will recommend, to the BoD, that the tree be removed. A plan was discussed to dredge the creek in such a way as to make it visible from the tee and not disturb the flow of the creek. Rocks would be used to line the bank as was done on the 12<sup>th</sup> fairway. Members of the committee will look at the 6<sup>th</sup> and make sketches of the intended work. Pete McNamara's plan for replacing 5 of the pine trees on the left side of the 8<sup>th</sup> fairway with 2 large Maple trees and 1 crimson maple, was reviewed.

We are waiting for the BoD approval for the work to begin on both projects.
