Steve S is ready to aerate the greens and tees prior to the summer season, but the weather has not been cooperating. He is working with Todd M to come up with 2 days to complete the work. Half of the course will closed each day. He will notify the membership via email and ask for volunteer help for both days. He will also aerate parts of some fairways. Bob M will send an email to the members of the plans of the pending aeration.

Sue K had suggested that it maybe be a good idea to have an Open House day to introduce members to the pro-shop and maintenance equipment. The group likes the idea and will try to schedule this for next spring.

Carl J said he has been asked to look into a new hard wood tree to the left of the 6^{th} green. After some discussion it was decided that it was not a good idea to plant a tree because of sun and drainage issues.

Carl J informed us that he is looking into donating "clip-on" divot mix containers. They would be made available near the pro-shop.

Bob M asked about adding additional forward tees to the course to even out the difference between women and men par. It was decided that we had several other projects to work on before we additional tees would be considered. The primary project should be reworking our existing bunkers. This work has been delayed for several years.

Sue K informed us that the work of moving the gazebo and building a fire pit is in the finial planning stages and the work should begin soon.
